Caron Family Trust:

As part of an improvement project the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) routinely manages access (driveways) onto the highway by issuing permits for existing driveways that meet current standards and policy, but have not been permitted. WisDOT may alter, relocate or remove driveways as part of a highway improvement or maintenance project. In some cases, the driveways are allowed to remain as is unless WisDOT documents a safety or operational problem.

The proposed improvement for this highway, currently scheduled to begin in the summer of 2016, is to mill and resurface the existing roadway.

In reviewing our records, we were unable to find record of a permit for the driveway to Highway 27 from your property in the Town of Radisson. At this time, the department feels that the existing conditions allow an **acceptable safety risk** for both the highway and driveway users for the driveway to remain at the existing location. You are receiving a permit for your access at the existing location.

The following special provisions apply:

- **An 18" x 30' culvert pipe with apron endwalls is required. Cleaning and inspection of the culvert pipe is the responsibility of the property owner and should be done periodically.**
- **Any proposed change in land use, traffic volume or type of vehicles utilizing this connection, for purposes other than its permitted use, will require the property owner(s) to contact the Department of Transportation to obtain a new permit.**

It was noted during a recent field inspection, that the culvert pipe on this driveway needs cleaning to maintain proper drainage and lacks the required apron endwalls necessary for impact safety and erosion control. Both of these requirements are the responsibility of the property owner.

Enclosed are two copies of a driveway application/permit document. Please review the document and make any necessary revisions to all items (1-27). After you have reviewed the document, please sign both copies of the permit, keep one for your records, and return the other copy to me. If you have any questions, please contact me at 715-635-5059.
